

‘How To Communicate More Effectively’ workshop

Workshop Outline:

The workshop titled "HOW TO COMMUNICATE MORE EFFECTIVELY" will approach the area of communication by primarily understanding this concept. Verbal and nonverbal communication will be explored within the group through different exercises, which would also include a lecturette on communication. Listening also falls into communicating effectively and will therefore also be tackled as will problems arising from nonattending.

Everybody communicates whether intentionally or not. It is part of being human. Whilst all of us grow into a world where we learn to communicate to get along, we do not always master the skills necessary to make our communication effective. Sometimes we might wonder why people do not respond to us in a way that we would like them to.
